


The Nativity icon offers us the unique opportunity to explore our relationship with God. This weekend will include time for prayer, reflection, small group sharing, the celebration of the Divine Eucharist and the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Bishop David was born in Vegreville, Alberta. He holds a Bachelor Degree in Theology and a Masters and Licentiate in Canon Law from Saint Paul University and a doctorate in Canon Law from the Pontifical Institute of Eastern Studies in Rome. He was in charge of the formation of future priests for the Ukrainian Catholic Church in Canada. He taught at the Faculties of Theology and Canon Law at Saint Paul University and the Metropolitan Andrey Sheptytsky Institute. Following his episcopal ordination in June 2002, Bishop David served as Auxiliary Bishop of the Archeparchy of Winnipeg. He was appointed Bishop of the Eparchy of Edmonton in January 2007.
