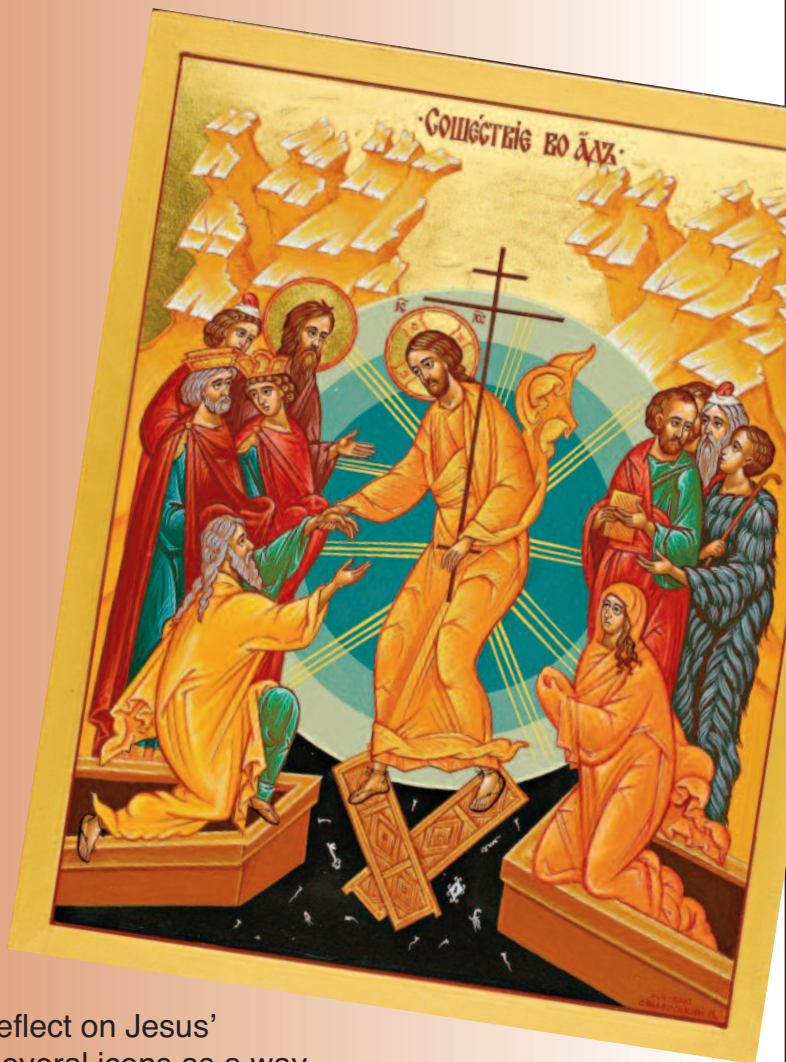

He holds a Bachelor of Theology Degree, a Master's and Licentiate in Canon Law from St. Paul University and a doctorate in Canon Law from the Pontifical Institute of Eastern Studies in Rome. He was in charge of the formation of future priests for the Ukrainian Catholic Church in Canada. He has taught at St. Paul University and the Metropolitan Andrey Sheptytsky Institute. Bishop David served as Auxiliary Bishop of the Archeparchy of Winnipeg before being appointed Bishop of the Eparchy of Edmonton in January 2007.
