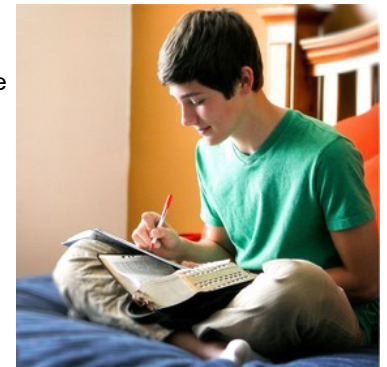

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Shroud of Turin: the most studied artifact in Christendom, St Josaphat, Edmonton

AGE: 10 - 110

DESCRIPTION: An official full size photographic replica on cotton cloth produced under the authority of the Archdiocese of Turin, Italy and gifted to Bishop David. Examine its amazing characteristics many of which can be discerned only because of advances in science and technology. Trace its most probable journey from the tomb of Christ to Turin, Italy. We will discuss: What have we learned from science about the authenticity of the cloth? Could it have been elsewhere other than Europe in its history? Are there connections between church prayers or art with the Shroud? Are there any other religious artifacts that shed light on the Shroud of Turin? If it is real, what does it mean for our faith?
