ABOUT THE BUILDING

St. Sophia Parish is building a 12,000 square foot church and multipurpose room in Sherwood Park.



With construction underway, the building is scheduled for completion in Fall of 2019. Its contemporary yet traditional design was completed by Concept Plus Architecture and Engineering, with construction contracting by Krawford Construction.
